The Central Texas Colony set up a \$1,000 yearly scholarship to help qualified descendants of Colony members go to college or trade school.

Here's what you need to qualify:

- 1. You must be the child or grandchild of a Central Texas Colony member.
- 2. You need to be a U.S. citizen.
- 3. You should be a high school senior planning to attend a 2-year or 4-year college, vocational, business, or technical school.

To apply, you'll need to send in the following:

- 1. A completed application form
- 2. A copy of your birth certificate (unless you're already a Junior Member)
- 3. A copy of your high school transcript
- 4. A copy of your SAT or ACT score
- 5. A 300-500 word essay on a given topic about the Mayflower Pilgrims

Make sure your entire application packet is sent in one package via USPS and postmarked by January 15, 2025.
