

## January 2025

The Houston Colony Scholarship - Texas Society of Mayflower Descendants has been established to assist deserving descendants of TXSOMD members in acquiring higher education, with a view to their becoming better prepared for life and citizenship.

In the spirit of the Mayflower settlers seeking to better themselves by moving to a new and uncharted world, special consideration will be given to applicants who have demonstrated commitment to bettering themselves and who will likely benefit from a scholarship.

A \$1,620 scholarship award will be paid directly to the US college, university, or community college in which the graduating senior student has been accepted for enrollment. The award will go to assist the student's payment for tuition and books only. If a student selected for the scholarship fails to enter a United States school of higher learning this fall, then they will forfeit the scholarship. The scholarship may then be awarded to the runner up at the discretion of the Houston Colony Scholarship - Texas Society of Mayflower Descendants Selection Committee.

Eligibility For Scholarship Criteria: What a student needs to do to qualify.

- Be a graduating high school senior in the Fall of 2024 or Spring of 2025.
- Plan to enter a US institution of higher learning (2- or 4-year or community college) in the fall of 2025 for the first time.
- Show proof of US citizenship with a copy of birth certificate or US passport.
- Show proof of Texas residence with a copy of valid Texas Driver's License,
  Texas ID card or high school student ID card.
- Show proof of GSMD, Texas and Houston Colony membership for you, your parent, or your grandparent through one of the following: the applicant's Texas Junior membership number or the applicant or their parent/grandparent's General Society of Mayflower Descendants (GSMD) or Texas Society of Mayflower Descendants (TXSOMD) membership number. Houston Colony Membership of any of the above will be checked with our Houston Colony Treasurer records.
- Submit an official high school transcript. If home schooled, submit copies of achievement scores.
- Properly complete and submit Application Form, pages 3-5.

2025 graduates must submit complete applications to arrive at a time on or before March 01, 2025.
